The collection of theses will be delivered to the office (warehouse) Nova Poshta chosen by the recipient. One author's copy of collection of research papers is sent to the address of the first author indicated in the conference application form. The fee for an extra copy is 100 UAN.

8. As a contributor wishes, the article will be published in the professional collection of research papers "Scientific Herald of International Humanitarian University. Series: Philology". The Scientific Herald of International Humanitarian University. Series: Philology was included in the list of scientific professional publications of Ukraine according to the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine # 455 of 15.04.2014 (appendix # 5). The Scientific Herald has also been indexed in the international database INDEX COPERNICUS (Poland). Follow the link http://vestnik-philology.mgu.od.ua/ to find formatting guidelines for authors.

Theses of students, undergraduates and postgraduates are submitted with the **review** of scientific adviser.

Registration fee - 100 UAH.

The publication fee - 50 UAN - 1 page.

Doctors' theses without co-authors are free of charge.

The electronic version of the collection of theses will be posted on the website of the faculty of Linguistics and Translation within two weeks after the conference.

Formatting guidelines

- 1. One copy of the printed manuscript should carefully be edited and signed by the author (by all the co-authors). The length of the thesis is up to 5 pages including the references. The summary and references are optional.
- 2. Please use page format A 4; page layout portrait; the margins: left 2,5 cm, right 2 cm, upper and lower 2 cm. Use Times New Roman size 14pt font (1.5 spaced), set indentation to 1 cm in Word throughout the manuscript.
- 3. References to works in the text are given in Arabic numerals and are enclosed in square brackets, if you provide a quotation, indicate page number as well, e.g. [1, 5-7]. If there are several references: [1-3; 5, 45-48; 7, 14-16].
- **4.** When writing theses one should follow the requirements for publications of Higher Attestation Commission of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. The thesis should include the following issues: formulation of the problem, urgency of an issue, the objective and tasks of the research, scientific results, argumentation, conclusions and prospects of further research.
